

ST. PETER, THE APOSTLE

St. Peter - son of Jonah was a native of Bethsida on the shore of Galilee. Settled in Capernaum, together with his brother Andrew he earned his living "fishing", until the Lord called him from being a "fisherman" to become a "fisher of men". Thenceforth he was called Kepha, (Aramaic word for "rock ",Petra or Petrus in Latin) and when he later declared his faith in Jesus as "the Christ, the son of living God" the Lord spontaneously declared him "Blessed", stating univocally: "upon this rock I will build my Church". After the resurrection of Jesus, Peter was among the first to whom the Lord appeared; it was he who presided over the election of Mathias, preached the first public sermon at Pentecost, addressed the Sanhedrin, received the Jewish and later the first pagan into the church; he performed the first public miracle, and spoke the decisive word at the first council of the church. St. Peter was a man of action. He was crucified on Vatican Hill, during the reign of Emperor Nero(c.67), but upside down in difference to his feelings of unworthiness at dying in the position in which the Lord had been page. crucified. On 29th June(c.268) the body was brought at St. Sebastian's catacomb, Rome and thenceforth his feast is celebrated on 29th June all over the world.

Attendance:

- Every pupil is expected to be punctual and regular at all classes and school functions. Pupils must be present in the school premises 5 minutes before the commencement of school hours.
- Late comers are liable to be sent home. They will be marked absent, even if they be allowed to attend classes.
- 3. Every pupil is expected to be present when the school re-opens.
- 4. If for any serious reason a pupil cannot attend school for more than 3 days consecutively, the Principal should be informed.
- A leave note should be submitted for every absence from school. Those who fail to comply with this rule may not be allowed to join classes.

- All leave applications should bear the signature of parents or in their absence the signature of the guardian. Failure to bring such an application for leave makes the student liable to be sent home.
- 7. Application for medical leave for more than 3 days should be accompanied with a medical certificate from a doctor who is MBBS and a registered medical practioner. If this leave continues for more than seven days, the Principal must be intimated.
- 8. No child suffering from any infectious or contagious disease should be sent to school.
- A student who is irregular to classes due to feast, marriage celebrations, trips, visits to relation and places and frequent late comers will be asked to discontinue. Extension of vacation without sanction by the Principal is not permitted.
- 10. Parents/guardians should fill in the 'Leave of absence record' when their son/ward comes back to school.
- 11. Participation and attendance in the National Festivals, like Independence Day and Republic Day is a must. Every pupil must take part in school games and other activities unless declared physically unfit by Medical Certificate or exempted by the Principal.
- 12. Pupils are not permitted to leave the school premises during school hours without the written permission of the Principal.
- 13. Parents / guardians or visitors are not allowed to interview pupils or teachers during school hours without the written permission of the Principal. Hence parents/guardians are advised to meet teachers only by prior appointment.

DIRECTIVES / RECOMMENDATIONS TO PUPILS

- Only English should be spoken within School premises. This will enable them to express themselves better in written and or all work.
- 2. No pupils should remain in the class-room during recess.
- 3. Pupils themselves are responsible for their own books, fountain pens, cycles, tiffin carriers or any other articles they may bring to school.
- 4. It is the duty of pupils to see that the school premises are kept clean and tidy.
- 5. Pupils are expected to take care of the school property. Any damage caused to school property must be made good.
- 6. Pupils are responsible to school authorities not only for their conduct in school but also their general behaviour outside. Any report of objectionable conduct on the part of any pupil (if on enquiry found true) will make him/her liable for disciplinay action. Hence misbehavior in public and conveyance is liable to the same action.
- 7. The school authorities also reserve the right of suspending/dismissing any pupil whose conduct in their opinion is not satisfactory.
- 8. Irregular attendance, insubordination to teachers, obstinacy in word and deed, neglect of work, habitual lack of interest in school work, stealing, misconduct even outside the school premises, willful, repeated breaches of school regulations are sufficient reasons which make him/her liable to disciplinary action.

- 9. A pupil may be sent home during school hours for violating any of the school rules.
- 10. Collection for any purpose requires Principal's sanction.
- 11. Gifts to members of the staff or arrangement of functions by students requires previous sanction of the Principal.
- 12. No literature of any kind which is not directly connected with the school curriculum be brought to school.
- 13. No Student should ever enter the school premises without wearing his/her ID card failing which he/she may be imposed a penalty.
- 14. If a student is detected bringing to school any tobacco related material or found chewing Bubble gum inside the class/school premises, he/she may severely be dealt with.
- 15. Bringing & using mobile phone into the classroom is strictly forbidden. Students not adhering to the instructions will severely be punished. Their mobiles will be confiscated and will not be returned.

Hints on How to Study:

- In the class-room: Pay great attention. You will learn faster and have to study less, moreover you will have no time to talk or fool around. Ask questions about what you do not understand.
- At Home: First review what you have learnt in the class, then do your written work. In this way you will do your work correctly and quickly.
- 3. During your study concentrate on your work. Put away all things that distract you: Comics, playthings,

- Radio, T.V., video, noise. Do not waste time. Don not dream, keep awake and go ahead with your work.
- Never omit your home work- Do what you were given in the class and in the way you were taught to do it in class. It is essential that you note down correctly in your diary your study assignment.

Directives / Recommendations to Parents

- Parents are expected to co-operate with the school authorities in enforcing regularity and discipline. They should see to it that their wards prepare their lessons and take active interest in the activities of the school.
- 2. Parents should not encourage their wards to stay at home on a school working day or attend functions which may come in the way of studies.
- 3. Reports and recommendations from the teachers/Principals written in the diaries should be signed by parents. Failure to do so may put the child to great inconvenience.
- 4. It is very much appreciated when parents respond readily and attend the Parents-Teachers-Meeting and school events whenever they are held. It is only with the co-operation of the parents that the school can promote the all-round development of pupils.
- 5. Parents are requested to foster in their wards habits of neatness and punctuality, qualities of politeness and courtesy of speech.
- 6. No private tuitions should be arranged without the permission of the Principal.
- 7. If parents arrange private tuitions for their wards with the teachers of our institution without the permission

- of the Principal, such parents will be asked to withdraw their children from school.
- 8. Parents are requested to take away their children within 15 minutes after the school hours. In case of any problem of arranging conveyance or delay in the arrival of regular conveyance, the parents have to give clear and standing instruction to their wards NEVER TO LEAVE the school campus until such time alternate arrangement is made to go home.

Library Rules:

- 1. All students are encouraged to make good use of the library.
- A student is permitted to take only one book per week.
- 3. Books are issued to the use of the borrower and should not be lent to anybody else. Reference books will not be issued.
- 4. No student is allowed to keep a book for more than a week without permission. Defaulters will be fined.
- 5. A student who loses or damages a book will be fined.
- 6. All library books should be returned at least two weeks before the winter vacation and the annual assessment.

School Fees:

- 1. The amount of fee charged at the time of admission is not refundable.
- 2. Fees are charged for full academic year irrespective of the date of admission.
- 3. No concession or reduction in fee is made on

account of change in academic session, broken period, holidays or absence from class for any reason.

4. Fee must be paid in advance in cash only regularly through the Bill Book as per 'Instruction to parents/guardians (in Bill Book).

Fee must be deposited quarterly by the 15th of the following months. ie. April, July. October & January of the academic year.

5. In case of non-payment of fees a students' name will be struck off the rolls/or may not be allowed to appear for the examinations.

N.B Parents/guardians are requested to read these regulations and see that they and their wards follow them meticulously. Ignorance of them will be no excuse.

- 2. The students will be assessed on the basis of their class room performance and exams to ensure that the process of assessment is continuous, smooth and competent on each term.
- 3. Each term will comprise of a unit assessment and a terminal exam.
- 4. A minimum of 40% in the final aggregate in every subject is required for promotion.
- 5. Promotion will not be granted to students failing in Moral Science, G.K. or SUPW.
- 6. Pupils who are detected giving or attempting to give or obtain unfair assistance whatsoever, during an examination, will have their result cancelled in that particular subject and may be asked to be withdrawn from the school.
- 7. A progress report will be issued after every assessment. The progress report of all the assessment & exams should be returned duly signed by the parents, within 3 days of receipt.
- 8. Pupils absent from any test/examination will be considered to have failed in that test/examination. No absentee will be re-examined. In case of illness a medical certificate should be submitted.
- 9. All students should put in an attendance of at least 80% of the working days. Any pupil falling short of the required attendance will not be granted promotion to for consideration in promotion.
- 10. Any pupil failing two years in succession will be asked to leave the school.
- In all matters of promotion or failure, the Principal's decision is final and binding. (No argument by the parents for undeserving promotion will be entertained)

- 12. Those parents who wish to withdraw their wards immediately after the Result has been declared in the month of March have to apply for the Transfer Certificate by 10th of April failing which they have to pay a month's fee in lieu thereof. Generally it takes a week after submitting the withdrawal form to issue the 'Transfer Certificate'
- 13. Application for Transfer Certificate shall be made to the Principal by the parents/guardians of the pupil on the prescribed form.


